## MINUTES OF THE BOARD MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 30, 1990

- Approved minutes of the Board meeting held on December 21, 1989
- B. FOR ENTRY INTO THE MINUTES
- 1. NYCOTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION

  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation to amend its simulcast plan of operation to charge a \$2.00 admission fee to their enhanced telebranch at 2696 Hylan Blvd., Staten Island, at such time as full food, restaurant service and alcoholic beverages (with SLA approval) are offered to the public.
- 2. NYCOTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION

  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation to amend its plan of operation to reflect the closing of its branch at 16 E. 52nd Street, New York City, effective with the close of business on December 20, 1989 and to amend its simulcast plan of operation to add the display of New York Racing Association, Finger Lakes and Yonkers Tuesday matinee simulcast at its licensed simulcast branch at 331 Park Avenue South, New York City, effective December 21, 1989.
- 3. APPLICATION OF NROTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval
  of an application of Nassau Regional Off-Track Betting
  Corporation to amend its simulcast plan of operation and
  add its Hicksville Branch as a licensed simulcast facility
  displaying simulcasts from Yonkers Raceway, effective
  December 28, 1989.
- 4. JOCKEY CLUB/APPOINTMENT OF STEWARDS
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of request by the Jockey Club to name Dr. Manuel Gilman as Steward representing The Jockey Club at all NYRA tracks. Also, Mr. Richard Hanson will continue as the Jockey Club Steward at Finger Lakes, and Alternate Steward at the New York Racing Association, along with Mr. William Garges.

- 5. NYRA/SIMULCAST TO KEENELAND SALES PAVILION
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval
  of a request by the New York Racing Association to simulcast
  the NYRA daily card from January 4 thru 11, 1990 to
  Keeneland Sales Pavilion solely for the viewing interest
  of horsemen attending the sale.
- 6. YONKERS RACEWAY/LICENSE AMENDMENT
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval
  of a request by Yonkers Raceway to add Sunday, December 31,
  1989 to the 1989 racing calendar, Post time will be 8:P.M.
  and 11 races will be conducted.
- 7. WROTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Western Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to amend its simulcast plan of operation and simulcast races from Yonkers Raceway into its Central Square simulcast branch, effective January 2, 1990.
- 8. WROTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Western Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to amend its plan of operation in relation to the simulcasting of races from Buffalo Raceway on Sundays commencing January 7, 1990.
- 9. CDROTBC/TO ACCEPT WAGERS
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Capital District Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to accept wagers on the 1989 Palos Verdes Handicap to be run on December 30, 1989 at Santa Anita Park, California as an out-of-region special event and to allow triple wagering thereon with (6) horses running.
- 10. NYRA/SIMULCAST TO WINDSOR RACEWAY
  For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval
  of a request by the New York Racing Association of an
  agreement between NYRA and Windsor Raceway for the simulcast
  and acceptance of pari-mutuel wagering on various
  races in the month of January and February as outlined in
  their letter of December 18, 1989.
- 11. SROTBC/TO DISPLAY THE COONEY-FOREMAN BOXING MATCH For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Suffolk Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to display the Cooney-Foreman boxing match at its Hauppauge simulcast theater on January 15, 1990 and to charge an admission fee (including dinner) of \$30.00.

19. SROTBC/TO OFFER A DELAYED CALL FROM GULFSTREAM RACETRACK For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Suffolk Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to offer a delayed call from Gulfstream Race Track on NYRA dark days to SROTBC'S non-simulcast branches as outlined in their letter of January 12, 1990.

## 20. YONKERS RACEWAY/PROMOTION

For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Yonkers Raceway to conduct a television giveaway on Monday, January 29th and Saturday, March 3, 1990. All patrons, who enter the track will receive a ballot, which will be available without purchase.

21. NYCOTBC ON BEHALF OF ITSELF, NASSAU, SUFFOLK, CATSKILL AND CDROTBC

For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation on behalf of itself, Nassau, Suffolk, Catskill and Capital District Regional Off-Track Betting Corporations, to simulcast races from Monticello Raceway into all licensed simulcast facilities on Wednesday evening when Yonkers Raceway is dark, beginning on January 17, 1990.

22. SROTBC/TO OFFER THE LIVE CALL
For entry into the minutes, the Chairman's prior approval of a request by Suffolk Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to offer the live call of races from Gulfstream Park, Florida on Tuesdays in all its branches.

## (C) PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY THE BOARD

- 1. APPRENTICE ALLOWANCE EXTENSION FOR JOCKEY ZACHARY O. SEBRETH For entry into the minutes, the Board's prior approval of a request by Jockey Zachary O. Sebreth for a 162-day extension of his weight allowance due to days lost as a result of a disabling injury.

  His allowance, when added to his current expiration date of January 6, 1990 would expire on June 17, 1990.
- 2. APPRENTICE ALLOWANCE EXTENSION FOR JOCKEY IRIS DE JESUS For entry into the minutes, the Board's prior approval of a request by Jockey Iris DeJesus for a 3-day extension of her apprentice allowance, due to dates lost to racing being canceled because inclement weather on November 16, 23, and December 22, 1989.

  Her allowance, when added to her current expiration date of January 15, 1990 would expire on January 18, 1990.

- 3. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF JOHN DESIMONE
  The Board approved the Hearing Officer's recommendation
  that John DeSimone be relicensed as a trainer only, as per
  consent and agreement.
- 4. IN THE MATTER OF KYLE DIBENEDETTO

  The Board approved the agreement signed by Mr. DiBenedetto, whereby his license would be reinstated as a trainer only, as per consent and agreement.
- 5. IN THE MATTER OF HARNESS TRAINER TROY ROSSI
  The Board approved the summary suspension of license harness trainer Troy Rossi for testing positive for marijuana on 1/13/90.

### D. BOARD DETERMINATION

- 1. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF SAM ALAIMO, OWNER The Board approved the Hearing Officer's recommendation that Mr. Alaimo be held in default and consequently that the judges' decision disallowing the protest herein be confirmed.
- 2. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF JAMES R. ALLEN The Board approved the recommendation of the Hearing Officer that the refusal of Mr. Allen's license be confirmed.
- 3. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF BARRY PROBBER
  The Board approved the recommendation of the Hearing Officer that the judges' 8-day suspension of Mr. Probber's license be confirmed.
- 4. FLRA/CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND
  The Board approved the request by Finger Lakes to withdraw \$15,992,73 from its Capital Improvement Fund.
- 5. CDROTBC/PROMOTION
  The Board approved the request by Capital District Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to conduct arm wrestling and dart tournaments as a promotional activity at their Albany Simulcast Theater and to charge a small entry fee to participate in these games of skill. Also, the Board approved the request to offer trophies and small awards (prizes not cash) to the winning participants.
- 6. APPRENTICE ALLOWANCE EXTENSION FOR JOCKEY JEFF CARLE
  The Board approved the request by Apprentice Jockey Jeff
  Carle for a seven day extension of his weight allowance
  due to days lost as a result of a race injury and days
  lost due to inclement weather. His allowance, when added to
  his current expiration date of February 4, 1990, would now
  expire on February 11, 1990.

- 7. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF ROBERT RICK DEBONIS
  The Board approved the Hearing Officer's recommendation
  that Mr. Robert Rick DeBonis be suspended for a period
  of 90 days, with credit for time already served and that
  he be required to submit to urine testing.
- 8. NYRA/INSTALLATION OF "TINY TIMS"
  The Board approved the request of NYRA dated December 14, 1989 to install "TINY TIMS" at its NYRA racetracks.
  This approval is conditioned upon their being programmed for use solely in the public areas of the track (to which admission is normally charged) and to remove their ability to cancel bets once such bets are sent to the Tote computer.
- 9. WROTBC/PROMOTION
  The Board aproved the request by Western Regional Off-Track
  Betting Corporation to undertake a promotional campaign for
  their Olean branch including give-aways, prizes, free food
  and non-alcoholic beverages on selected dates.
- 10. WROTBC/TO STUDY AND EVALUATE
  The Board approved the Western Regional Off-Track Betting
  Corporation's request for permission to more fully study and
  evaluate the following concepts:
  - 1. Moving its headquarters into a new or remodeled owned facility from its current leased facility; and
  - 2. construct and implement a new operations/computer center to serve WROTBC needs and serve as a centralized computer/ interface center for the Western Region's racetracks.

The Board has no objections to the study and evaluation, but the Board reserves any judgment on the feasability or desirability of such goals at this time.

11. PROPOSED RULES FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION

The Board approved the emergency adoption of the proposed rules as follows: The proposed rules would add two (2) new sections 5620.20 and 5621.21 and amendments to bingo sections 5812.10, 5820.12 and 5820.14 and amendments to games of chance sections: 56001. (m), (t), 5603.7, 5620.1(q), 5620.1(r), 5620.1(s), 5620.1(t), 56203.(c)(2), 56203.(d)(4), 5620.3(e)(1)(2)(3)(4)(5)(6)(7)(8)(9)(10) and (11), 5620.4(d)(1)(2)(3)(4)(5)(6) and (7), 5620.4(e)(1)(2) (3)(4)(5)(6)(7) and (8), 5620.5(f)(2), 5620.6(b)(3) and (4), 5620.8(b)(3), 5620.9(b)(3), 5620.11(b)(2), 5620.12(c)(6) and (7)(i), 5620.13(b)(2), 5620.14(b)(3), 5620.15(e), 5620.16(f) 5620.17(c), 5620.18(f), 5620.19(c)(1), 5621.1, 5621.4 heading, 5621.4, 5621.12. 5622.22 and 5624.16.

- 12. NYRA/HANDICAPPER'S CHALLENGE PROMOTION
  The Board approved the request by the New York Racing
  Association to conduct the New York Invitational
  Handicappers' Challenge as outlined in their letter of
  January 8, 1990. Also, the Board approved the request
  for free admission to be granted to finalists and
  semi-finalists of the contest and no purchase is necessary
  and entry forms are available outside the admission booth
  areas of the track.
- 13. APPLICATION OF CDROTBC/TO AMEND PLAN OF OPERATION
  The Board approved the application of Capital District
  Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation to amend its plan
  of operation to establish a new branch at 166 Columbia
  Turnpike, East Greenbush, and to close its existing branches
  in East Greenbush and Rensselear.
- 14. IN THE MATTER OF CHRIS ANTLEY, JOCKEY
  The Board decided to act on Chris Antley's application for licensure on or after March 15, 1990.

  It is anti+cipated that should Chris Antley continue to make progress toward rehabilitation and continue to test clean that a license will be granted at that time, subject to close monitoring and drug testing by the Board.
- 15. PROPOSED RULES FOR FINAL ADOPTION
  The Board approved the following proposed rules for final adoption: Sections 4009.19, 4009,20, 4011.20, and 4011.23 of the thoroughbred racing rules to increase the number of horse participating in a thoroughbred race.
- 16. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF PATRICK MURPHY
  The Board approved the recommendation of the Hearing Officer
  that the refusal of Mr. Murphy's license be confirmed
  (Chairman Corbisiero abstained from voting).
- 17. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF GENERAL WASHINGTON The Board approved the recommendation of the Hearing Officer that Mr. Washington's denial of a license to participate in harness racing be confirmed.

#### 18. RULE PROPOSALS

The Board approved the following proposed rule as amendments and/or repeals to its thoroughbred, harness and quarterhorse rules. These changes are merely technical in nature, and will enable the Board to act more effectively.

- 19. HEARING OFFICER REPORT IN THE MATTER OF JOSEPH J. BADAMO, JR. The Board approved the Hearing Office's recommendation that Mr. Badamo's jockey license as jockey be revoked.
- 20. YONKERS RACEWAY LATE ISSUED \$400 WINNING DAILY DOUBLE TICKET ON NYRA RACES WORTH \$36,200

The Board considered for the status of the \$400 winning Daily Double ticket from the 1st

NYRA Daily Double pool of June 26, 1989 which ticket failed to issue promptly from a ticket issuing machine at Yonkers Raceway and which is presently in the possession of Robert Galterio, General Manager, Yonkers Raceway.

It was the Board's decision that such ticket should be cashed by Yonkers Raceway and, should there be no objections, the proceeds distributed as follows: \$400 to Autotote, the Tote vendor, to reimburse it for its assumption of liability for the amount of the bet and the balance, \$35,800, to be inserted into a future NYRA Daily Double pay-off to reimburse the public for the underpayment of a forementioned Daily Double caused by the malfunctioning of the Tote system.

Objections to the Board's decision may be made until February 20, 1990 addressed to Thomas C. Davide, Secretary to the Board.

In the interim, Yonkers Raceway is directed to cash such ticket and hold the proceeds pending further directions.
