
In accordance with Chapter 346 of the Laws of 1973, I am pleased to submit to you the eleventh annual report of the Racing and Wagering Board.

Total racing revenues to government this year from both on- and off-track wagering reached \$217,216,381, of which \$119,209,744 went to the State, and \$98,006,637 was distributed to towns, cities and counties.

A detailed analysis of racing revenues for the calendar year 1983 is reported in the following pages, together with a summary of the Board's activities.

We, at the Board, appreciate the sincere and active interest you have shown in the problems which faced the horse racing industry this year. In particular, your Executive Order creating task forces to study and report on ways to strengthen the thoroughbred and harness racing industries was welcomed by all concerned.

REVIEW

While almost all economic indicators in 1983 pointed up, horse racing generally failed to benefit from the widely shared fiscal boom. For the first time ever combined on- and off-track handle failed to show an increase over the previous year. Although off-track handle increased slightly, the minimal margin was not enough to off-set a 2.06% decline in total on-track handle.

Three harness tracks (Vernon Downs, Saratoga and Yonkers Raceways) showed gains in average handle, and at the same time Buffalo, Monticello and Saratoga Raceways increased their average attendance. Only Batavia and Roosevelt Raceways ended the year with a drop in both average handle and average attendance.

Factors contributing to these declines are by now a familiar litany to racing fans: the weather, competition from other forms of gambling (lottery, jai alai in Connecticut, casino gambling in Atlantic City) off-track betting, the Meadowlands, football and the many other forms of metropolitan entertainment attracting leisure dollars.

Despite the dismal statistics, 1983 will undoubtedly be seen as a turning point in the development of the horse racing industry in New York. Legislative action taken this year is bound to have a positive effect on the pari-mutuel racing market for many years to come.

For the upstate harness tracks and Finger Lakes Racetrack, racing law was amended to permit them to increase their pari-mutuel takeout by one percent on regular and multiple wagering, with the added funds to be used to add, replace or remodel their physical plants and equipment. (Monticello was not included because a previous concession granted for its winter meeting was extended for an additional year). Off-track betting corporations accepting wagers on tracks which opt to come under this law are required to increase their takeout by one percent and contribute one-half of the funds thus generated to the track's project and retain the other half for the OTB corporation's use.

Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceways were aided by the two-year extention of a tax reduction originally granted from July 1981 and due to expire this year. This tax relief will be in effect until June 30, 1985.

At Finger Lakes, before the takeout increase for Capital Construction was enacted, takeout was increased from 17% to 19% on daily double and exacta wagering, with half of the increase ear-marked for purses, and the other half reverting to the track. Win, place, show and triple wagering were not affected.

Finally, major legislation affecting the New York Racing Association was passed and signed into law. Under the provisions of the bill, NYRA's franchise was extended until December 31, 2000. The New York State Thoroughbred Racing Capital Investment Fund was created to administer the refinancing and improvement of the NYRA tracks. The fund is to be financed by the revenues received by NYRA for wagering conducted outside New York on NYRA races and by revenues from simulcasting NYRA races within the State, as well as an annual \$1.85 million tax on N.Y.R.A.

Another bill affecting NYRA was signed in August 1983 allotting one percent of the State's share of handle on multiple bets (daily double, exacta and quinella) to be used to increase purses as of April 1, 1984. This one percent increase for purses was made possible by a one percent decrease in the state's tax, which dropped to 4%.

The New York Racing Association was also mandated to allot 1% of all purse money from NYRA races to the horsemen's association representing the majority of horsemen at NYRA tracks. This fund must be used for horsemen's benefits, particularly benevolent activities for backstretch employees, for the further development of equine research, or administrative costs of the association.

The successful experiment in live simulcasting of races from Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceways authorized by legislation in 1981 was extended through all of 1983. Although the test was limited to two OTB branches in Staten Island and two in Suffolk County, comparative statistics continue to show OTB harness handle well above the pre-simulcasting levels in those branches.

In August the transmission of live calls of the races from Yonkers Raceway into certain branches of New York City, Suffolk, Nassau and Catskill Off-Track Betting Corporations was approved by the Board. This innovation provided track odds changes until a few minutes before post time and payoff prices shortly after the finish of the race.

Several significant court decisions on litigation resulting from Board rulings were issued this year, among them:

Vasquez v. Van Lindt, et al.

The United States Court of Appeals (Second Circuit) denied jockey Jacinto Vasquez' appeal of the denial to him of a preliminary injunction and ordered that the civil rights complaint be dismissed.

The Federal Appeals Court held that each of the jockey's claims had been previously raised in State Court and could not be relitigated.

Lasky v. Van Lindt, et al.

The Appellate Division, First Department, affirmed a lower court ruling which sustained the Board in its determination that licensing a person engaged in touting activities is detrimental to the integrity of racing.

Venezia v. Van Lindt, et al.

Jockey Michael Venezia's motion in the Appellate Division, First Department, for the re-argument or leave to appeal to the Court of Appeals was denied.

MacMillen v. New York State Racing and Wagering Board

The Court of Appeals upheld the Board's authority to require thoroughbred owners to maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance for jockeys who ride for them.

Kaufman v. Sarafan

The New York Court of Appeals upheld the Board's determination denying the protest of a race.

Messenger v. Racing and Wagering Board

The Board's revocation of this harness license was upheld. The Board had determined that Messenger lied regarding betting on a suspicious race.


Cordero v. Van Lindt

A determination by the Board regarding the jockey's riding violation was upheld by the Supreme Court, Queens County.

In three court cases the Appellate Division, First Department, upheld the Board's suspensions of three trainers' licenses based on the administration of drugs to race horses in violation of Board rules. *Johnson v. Van Lindt, et al*, *Drolet v. Van Lindt, et al*, and *Regan v. Van Lindt, et al* were the first recent substantive decisions involving application of the Board's drug testing program.

Effective July 1, 1983 the Board increased the allowable number of owners for any horse to 35 persons, each to be licensed by the Board. Previously, ownership was limited to 15 persons in thoroughbred and 10 persons in harness and quarter horse. This action is expected to generate greater interest and more widespread involvement in the racing and breeding industry in New York.

New rules were adopted setting minimum occupational licensing standards for thoroughbred trainers, farriers and jockey agents. The Board also revised rules pertaining to claiming by creating new open claiming provisions and allowing for the voiding of claims under certain circumstances (e.g., drugs, undisclosed pregnancy of a mare.)

THOROUGHBRED RACING

Total average daily handle and attendance at the NYRA tracks was down this year, even though Belmont and Saratoga showed an increase in both areas. A 6.58% decrease in average daily attendance and a 3.87% drop in average handle at Aqueduct was enough to cause attendance and handle at NYRA to drop 2.50% and .05% respectively from last year's figures. The 1983 Saratoga meet was the most successful ever, beating the record average daily handle set in 1981.

Finger Lakes was down 4% in attendance and minimally in handle for the year.

The New York Racing Association's development of simulcasting opportunities took a new turn in March when an agreement was reached with a casino in Las Vegas, Nevada, Caesars Palace, to simulcast all NYRA races there on a daily basis.

Under the terms of the agreement, the casino pay-off will be at track odds. (Since October 1979 NYRA has been simulcasting races on a daily basis to a teletrack facility in New Haven, Connecticut, which has a separate pool.)

In addition to Nevada and Connecticut, NYRA this year simulcast certain races to tracks in ten other states (Arizona, California, Colorado, Illinois, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Washington and West Virginia) and Mexico. Revenue to the State from these sources (except Connecticut, which is accounted for separately) amounted to \$61,008.88 from January 1, 1983 through June 30, 1983. After that revenues were diverted to the Capital Construction Fund. Revenue to the State from betting in Connecticut on NYRA races was \$718,300.80 for the period until June 30, 1983. Commission payment to NYRA from Connecticut amounted to \$2,183,985.

Simulcasting was largely responsible for two records set at Belmont this year. The entire Belmont Stakes Day card of nine races produced a record handle of \$18,157,510 from wagering at 23 racetracks in the United States and Mexico, and the off-track betting facilities in New York and Connecticut. The single race record for handle was set by the \$8,257,580 wagered on the Belmont Stakes alone.

The New York State Breeding and Development Fund Corporation reported receipts for 1983 of \$10,839,077, topping the \$10,766,565 received in 1982. This amount represents .5% of the on-track and off-track handle. Of the 1983 total, \$4,162,206 is allocated for the enrichment of purses for New York Bred restricted races at the New

York Racing Association tracks and at Finger Lakes Race Track. This year 31 stake races for New York Breds were held at NYRA tracks and 10 at Finger Lakes, with purses ranging from \$30,000 to \$100,000. A total of 637 Breeders awards were given to breeders of horses that earned any portion of the purses in any New York race. These awards amounted to \$3,882,957. In addition, 144 Stallion Owner Awards were paid to owners of stallions which sired purse winners in any New York races. These payments totalled \$796,961. Owner premiums were awarded to owners racing in open competition in New York. These premiums amounted to \$907,218, and were shared by 302 individuals, partnerships or other entities. The amount of the premiums this year increased by 64.6% over the 1982 awards.

HARNESS RACING

At all harness tracks combined this year handle and attendance were down from 1982 levels, and the handle on harness races at off-track betting facilities declined by 7.38%. Vernon Downs and Yonkers Raceways ended the year slightly ahead in handle, while at Monticello and Buffalo Raceways attendance rose 6.8% and 3.03% respectively. Only Saratoga Raceway improved in both handle (5.01%) and attendance (.94%). Yonkers Raceway had the highest average per capita handle of any track, thoroughbred or harness, \$203.53.

A series of bills signed into law this year were designed to strengthen the position of harness racing in the state and are expected to have a favorable impact on the industry in the near future.

QUARTER HORSE

There has been unusual interest in the resumption of racing, including quarter horse racing, at Tioga Park and Parr Meadows.

At Tioga Park the owners have decided to resume operations and advised the Board they plan to file an application for a racing license shortly. At Parr Meadows a prospective purchaser has deposited \$675,000 with the trustee in bankruptcy and indicated the property would be used for racing purposes.

LICENSING AND INVESTIGATIONS

The Board this year adopted rules extending licensing to include all participants in Thoroughbred racing. Previously non-racing personnel in the Thoroughbred sector (administrative, racing officials, concessionaires, vendors, mutuel clerks, and security personnel) have not

been licensed, while their counterparts in Harness and Quarter Horse racing were covered under the licensing program. The new licensing regulation is expected to encompass approximately 5000 additional licensees at the NYRA tracks and Finger Lakes.

During the year 30,039 licenses were issued by the Board, of which 11,992 were in Thoroughbred and 18,947 in Harness. A total of 12,479 fingerprint cards were submitted for processing - 12,169 for racing purposes, and 310 for off-track betting personnel.

The investigative staff conducted 314 investigations into matters involving licensee backgrounds, financial responsibility, prior arrest and convictions, race fixing, narcotic activity, organized crime involvement, horse drugging, hidden ownership, simulcasting, public safety and personnel screening.

AUDITS

Audits of all licensed Harness tracks and also the Finger Lakes Race Track are conducted annually pursuant to the Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law.

Field examinations of the racing operations at Yonkers and Monticello were completed through 1982, and for other corporations the racing operations through 1981 were covered by field examinations.

Also preliminary reviews and analyses of 1982 racing operations were completed for all racing corporations. Reports of audit findings when completed are submitted to the Governor and the Legislature.

OFF-TRACK BETTING

An increase in handle of \$10,706,790 gave the six OTB corporations an increase of .70% over 1982. Only the New York City OTB Corporation handle declined, for the second year in a row, down 1.90% from 1982.

Revenue to the State amounted to \$34,152,825, a decline of 2.11%, while revenue to towns, cities and

Of the 50 hearings scheduled against individuals due to licensing, racing and horse drugging infractions, 34 were completed and 16 appeals are pending.

The computer system installed in 1982 now contains all of the current Harness licensees, and many of the Thoroughbred. It is also being utilized to establish a post-race positive drug testing file which includes the names of drugged horses, types of drugs used, the race track on which the use occurred and the principals involved. A similar pre-race file is being developed.

To comply with the state's drug testing program all Thoroughbred and Harness horses racing in New York must undergo pre-race testing. The following statistics cover both pre- and post-race testing:

counties, including the surcharge revenue, fell 4.34% to \$96,652,072.
New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation:

This is the largest OTB region in the State, with 130 branch offices, one telephone betting center, and 2,704 employees. Their total handle for 1983 was \$866,764,759 which is greater than the combined handle of the other five OTB regions.

Although total handle was down, an increase in harness handle at the two simulcast branches in Staten Island and at the ten branches participating in a 3-month experiment with live calls of the races from Yonkers Raceway perhaps averted an even greater decrease.

In 1983 the Gross Benefit to the Corporation (including surcharge and breakage) on a handle of \$866,764,759 was 5.5% or \$48,322,285, while Operating Expenses were 10.8% or \$93,259,674.

New York City OTB returned over \$14.5 million to the State, \$42.9 million to the tracks and horsemen, and \$4.2 million to the breeding funds this year.

Nassau County Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation:

The second largest OTB corporation in handle, Nassau County has 24 branch locations. Total handle this year was \$159,442,909, a 2.66% increase over 1982. Handle on thoroughbred racing increased by 6.62%, while harness handle declined by 6.07% for the same period.

Gross benefit to the Corporation amounted to \$13,868,972 or 8.70% of total handle, the largest percentage of all the OTB corporations. Operating Expenses of \$12,468,061 were 7.8% of handle.

The three-month experiment with live calls of harness racing from Yonkers into six branches increased the average daily handle at those branches by \$7,861 per branch during the test period.

Suffolk Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation:

Suffolk is the fourth largest in handle of the six OTB corporations. Total handle increased by 4.58 over 1982, while harness handle increased .99%. The corporation's 27 branches employ 450 people.

Total handle of \$136,539,171 provided Gross Benefits of \$10,850,060 or 7.95%, while Operating Expenses were 8.9% of handle, \$12,216,361.

The experiment involving two branches into which races from Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceways were simulcast began in March 1982, and has proved highly successful. Live calls of races from Yonkers were introduced in August 1983 with similar results in improved handle for the six branches involved in the experiment.

Catskill Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation:

Catskill OTB Corporation includes eight counties and operates 30 branch offices, with 300 employees. Although the smallest of the six OTB corporations, handle this year reached \$88,668,362, improving over 1982 by 7.4%.

Gross Benefits were \$6,560,189 (7.40% of handle), and Operating Expenses of \$8,025,956 amounted to 9.1% of total handle.

Unlike other regions, Catskill was unable to experiment with live calls of downstate harness racing in 1983 because of its proximity to Monticello Raceway.

Capital District Off-Track Betting Corporation:

Capital District covers fourteen upstate counties and operates 53 branches employing 690 persons. Corporate handle in 1983 reached \$124,920,812, an increase of 7.76% over last year.

Gross Benefits were \$7,979,182 or 5.93% of handle. Operating Expenses of \$15,114,065 were 11.2% of total handle, the highest percentage of the six OTB Corporations.

Western Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation:

Western is the third largest OTB corporation and covers fifteen counties, with two participating municipalities, Buffalo and Rochester. There are 62 branch offices with 497 employees.

Operating Expenses were 10.5% of net handle, and amounted to \$15,286,480. Gross Benefits to the Corporation were \$9,071,384, or 6.21% of handle.

Total handle rose 1.1% over 1982, but a very significant gain in thoroughbred handle on Finger Lakes races occurred. This year for the first time the Western Region offered wagering on Finger Lakes within a few minutes of post-time with the result that handle increased 18% over 1982. In order to stem the downward drift in harness handle the corporation plans to offer the same late post-time wagering in 1984 on both Buffalo and Batavia Raceways.

BINGO

Gross receipts for Bingo games conducted this year amounted to \$227,655,753, as reported by the 3,148 authorized organizations.

Net profit to the participating organizations was \$63,077,697 and revenue to the municipalities amounted to \$3,211,115. During the year 23,782,264 persons played in 150,197 bingo occasions.

The license fee for the conduct of an occasion of bingo is \$18.75, of which \$11.25 is remitted to the State and \$7.50 retained by the municipality. Participating organizations are also required to pay an additional license fee of 3% of net profit which is retained wholly by the municipality for the enforcement of the applicable laws and rules.

The State realized \$1,871,013 from bingo fees this year, including the license fees collected from qualified suppliers of equipment which amounted to \$23,345. The amount of the supplier's fee, which is retained wholly by the State, is determined by a statutory schedule based upon the supplier's gross sales.

During 1983, 7,380 identification numbers were issued by the Board to organizations in the 868 municipalities which have enacted local laws or ordinances permitting the conduct of bingo on a local option basis. In addition to issuing supplier's licenses and identification numbers, the Board also must approve maximum rentals chargeable by licensed commercial lessors, approve the expenditure of bingo funds by organizations and hear appeals relating to municipal determinations.

A bill amending the State Constitution's restrictions on prize limits received second passage this year. The proposed amendment would permit the legislature to establish the prize limits for bingo and games of chance and will be submitted to the electorate at a statewide referendum in November 1984. If approved, it is anticipated that enabling legislation will be enacted to raise prize limits in both programs.

GAMES OF CHANCE

From the 1,325 organizations conducting licensed

games of chance, gross receipts for 1983 amounted to \$4,823,468, an increase of 4%. Net profits were \$3,492,076, a 4% increase over 1982.

The Board is empowered to issue identification numbers to authorized organizations, to approve the expenditure of funds derived from the conduct of games of chance and license the suppliers of the equipment for such games. Since the program's inception, 2,287 games of chance identification numbers have been issued.

By the end of 1983, 482 municipalities had passed local laws or ordinances permitting games of chance license periods on a local option basis.

Authorized organizations pay a fee of \$25 for each license period, of which \$15 goes to the State and \$10 to the municipality.

Licensed lessor organizations are assessed a fee of \$50 which is divided equally between the State and the municipality. The law also provides for an additional license fee, established by the Board at 5% of the organization's net profits to be used by the municipalities for the enforcement of applicable laws and rules. This fee is retained wholly by the municipality.

The supplier's fee, payable to and retained by the State, has been established at \$25 plus 2% of the supplier's gross sales or rentals.
