A storm water system has been designed to collect storm water flow from all proposed development areas including rooftops, parking lots, roadways and landscaped areas. The collected storm water will be discharged into specially engineered storm water basins which are designed to provide treatment and attenuation of storm water for a variety of storm intensities. Treatment will be accomplished through a combination of infiltration and micro pools. The utmost care was taken in the design process to maintain the pristine nature of the receiving waters, Lake Kiamesha. The system and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan has been reviewed and approved by the New York State DEC.

The storm water basins are designed to fully drain over an extended period time and therefore there is no potential for reuse of the water for other purposes such as irrigation. However, as previously noted, the infiltration components of each basin will provide for replenishment of groundwater.
