A motion to approve the following resolution was made by Trustee Slota and seconded by Trustee King.

Motion Carried - Vote:

Ayes – 4 (*Slota, King, Balles, Deemie*) **Nays** – 0 **Absent** – 1 (*Marusich*)

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of New York overwhelmingly voted in the affirmative to amend §9 of Article 1 of the Constitution to allow the authorization for up to seven Class III casinos in New York State, and

WHEREAS, the Governor announced that the first four casinos will be built in Upstate New York, including at least one in the Southern Tier/Central Region, which includes the Village of Johnson City and the Town of Union in Broome County, and

WHEREAS, it is projected that the construction of these Class III casinos will promote significant job growth, increase aid to schools, and permit local governments to lower property taxes through revenues generated for the host communities, which would accordingly inure to the benefit of the Village of Johnson City and the Town of Union in the event that the Traditions Resort and Conference Center site is selected, now, there be it

RESOLVED, that in furtherance of the above goals, the Village of Johnson City Board of Trustees hereby declares its support for locating one of the proposed casinos at the Traditions Resort and Conference Center in the Town of Union and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the New York State Gaming Commission, Governor Andrew Cuomo, New York State Senator Thomas Libous, and New York State Assemblywoman Donna Lupardo.

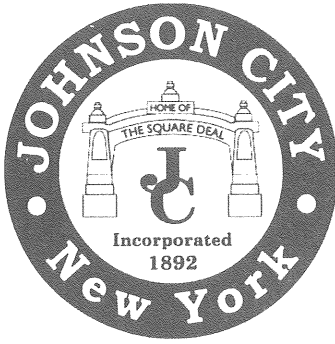
