Commission veterinarians are unconditional advocates for equine health, welfare and safety.

Job Description

- Responsible for all matters concerning the physical condition of horses to be raced at the track as to soundness and freedom from defect or contagious disease.
- In charge of enforcement of laws, rules and regulations forbidding use of certain drugs and stimulants.
- Assist in the conduct of investigations in event of positive drug tests and equine injuries or fatalities.
- Obtain blood samples and supervise the taking of urine samples and storage of all samples for testing.
- Supply technical information on drugs and their effects and acts as an expert witness at hearings.
- Assist in the determination of fitness of racing entrants and reports such as matters to the racing officials.
- Some travel may be required depending upon location.

Minimum Qualifications

Candidates must have a degree in Veterinary Medicine and a current, valid New York State Veterinary License.

During the term of employment, candidates may not have any involvement whether personal or business in any part of horse racing or have any other conflict of interest with racing participants within the past 3 years.
