Both horses drift out through the stretch brushing slightly early on. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 1- Inquiry into the stretch, in the vicinity of the 3/8 pole #2 Midnight Champagne (Able Castellano, Jr.) while racing on the rail has to steady behind #8 More Than Rainbows (Kendrick Carmouche) as #2 Midnight Champagne moved into tight quarters. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 7- Inquiry into the start, #11 Monster Bea (Juan Acosta) stumbled at the start and unseated his rider. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Equine Death Race 4- #9 Bam Bam trained by William Mott and ridden by Christopher DeCarlo was pulled up in the vicinity of the 1/4 pole and was taken off on the horse ambulance and was later humanely euthanized.

Incident Race 6- #9 Latigo Trail trained by Bruce Brown and ridden by Manuel Franco was eased inside the 1/8 pole while racing near the leaders and walked off the track under his own power.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 6- Jockey of the third place finisher #9 Triple Play (Manuel Franco) claimed foul against the second place finisher #7 Regal Minister (Eric Cancel) for alleged interference in the stretch. Approaching and passing the 1/8 pole, #9 Triple Play drifts in several paths down towards #7 Regal Minister inside. #7 Regal Minister then drifts out approaching the 1/16 pole, with #9 Triple Play close behind. #9 Triple Play steadies as a result and continues to finish third two lengths behind #7 Regal Minister. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 6- #6 Mr. Amos trained by Randi Persaud and ridden by Dylan Davis was horse ambulated off after the finish of the race and the claim was voided.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 6- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #10 Tennessee Whiskey (Silvestre de Sousa) claims foul against first place finisher #3 Moon Medal (Manuel Franco) for alleged interference in the stretch. Inside the 1/16 pole, #3 Moon Medal reacting to a left handed crop drifts out as #10 Tennessee Whiskey is racing outside of him. After reviewing the race video and speaking to all riders involved the claim of foul for this incident is disallowed. Also an inquiry into stretch, inside the 1/8 pole #11 Orient Harbor (Joel Rosario) is steadied against the portable rail as #5 Lamontagne (Eric Cancel) shifts in. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards #5 Lamontagne is disqualified from second and placed sixth. The new order of finish is 3, 2, 10, 7, 11, 5, 8, 4, 9, 1, 12, 13.
