Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #2 In the Beat (Samuel Camacho, Jr.) claimed foul against second place finisher #5 Ganador (Kevin Gomez) for alleged interference in the stretch. Approaching the 1/16 pole #5 Ganador drifts out and #2 In the Beat steadies behind. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the race is official as is. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 4- #10 El Genio trained by James Iselin and ridden by Jose Lezcano was taken up inside the 1/16 pole and walked off the track under his own power.

Stewards Inquiry Race 4- Inquiry into the stretch run, inside the 1/16 pole as the second place finisher #2 Nagging Gige (Christopher DeCarlo) drifts out and brushes with #6 Take a Bow (Luis Saez) carrying him out and then approaching the finish #2 Nagging Gige comes out again carrying out #6 Take a Bow. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards this incident altered the finish of the race and #2 Nagging Gige is disqualified from second and placed third. New order of finish is: 7, 6, 2, 1, 4.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 2- Jockey of the eight place finisher #4 Wildniteattheopera (Kendrick Carmouche) claims foul against fourth place finisher #5 Power Crazed (Angel Cruz) for alleged interference. After passing the 3/8 pole #4 Wildniteattheopera checks on the rail as #5 Power Crazed passes. #5 Power Crazed continues to finish fourth and #4 Wildniteattheopera tired to finish a distant last. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Trainer Objection Race 4- Trainer of the second place finisher #9 Carysfort Reef (Cornelio Velasquez) claims foul against the first place finisher #6 Text Me (Luis Saez) for alleged interference in the stretch. The #6 Text Me and the #9 Carysfort Reef brushed slightly in the stretch run and #6 Text Me goes on to win by a head. After reviewing the race video and speaking to the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Ruling- Linda Rice- Trainer- Having received a report from the New York Drug Testing and Research Program for the finding of the drug "Clenbuterol" in the bodily fluid samples of horse "La Verdad" who finished 1st in the 4th race at Saratoga Race Course on July 29, 2015. Trainer Linda Rice is hereby suspended 30 days and fined \$1000.00. Horse La Verdad is hereby disqualified from any share of the purse money and unplaced in the order of finish. For having waived your right of appeal 15 days are stayed pending no horse trained by you has a equine positive in a pari-mutuel jurisdiction on or before January 25, 2016.

Ordered that during your period of suspension , you shall not directly or indirectly participate in New York State Pari-mutuel horse racing. You are denied the privileges and use of the grounds for all racetracks, you are forbidden to participate in any share of the purses or other payments. Every horse is denied the privileges of the grounds and shall not participate in pari-mutuel racing in New York State, that (a) is owned or trained by you, or by individuals who serve as your agent or employee during your suspension; or (b) for which you during your suspension are directly or indirectly with training, including any arrangements to care for, train, enter, race, invoice, collect fees or other payments, manage funds, employ or insure workers, provide advise or other information or otherwise assist with any aspect of the training of such horse.
