**Jockey Movie Review Race 9-** Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Hugh Gallagher and James Edwards met with riders Gabriel Saez, Irad Ortiz, Jr. and Manuel Franco to review the running of the race in the vicinity of the 3/8 pole that caused one horse to steady. After review the Stewards stressed the safety of other riders and horses and that horses on the outside can help to reduce pressure.

In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole, #6 Free N Clear drifted out some then came back down causing #7 Bareeqa to steady slightly. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.
