In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole #5 Gioia Stella shifts out as the #1 Conquest Lucknlove (John Velazquez) takes a step out and then #5 Gioia Stella makes contact with #4 Truth. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

No Incidents Occurred

Jockey Movie Review Race 5- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with rider Kendrick Carmouche to review him coming out while riding #5 Gioia Stella in the stretch and making contact with #4 Truth. After review the Stewards issued a \$1,500 fine for careless riding and stressed the safety of both the horses and riders.

Jockey Movie Review Race 6- Stewards Stephen Lewandowski, Braulio Baeza and James Edwards met with rider Manuel Franco to review him coming in after the start on #5 Cats Landing. After review the Stewards issued a warning for coming over on other horses as safety of the horse and riders are paramount.
