Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #2 Axtell (Jose Lezcano) claims foul against second place finisher #5 Gee Pea Ess (Jose Ortiz) for alleged interference in the stretch. Inside the 1/16 pole #5 Gee Pea Ess drifts out towards #4 Dr. Edgar (Aaron Gryder) on the outside and #2 Axtell has to steady behind #5 Gee Pea Ess. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident did not alter the finish of the race and the race is official as is. Decision is unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 2- In the vicinity of the four and a half furlong pole #8 Ethan Hunt (Javier Castellano) shifts in towards the rail making contact with #4 Three to Thirteen (Eric Cancel) who then squeezes #3 Flagofpomeroy (Aaron Gryder) and #1 Follow the Signs (Luis Saez) along the rail. #4 Three to Thirteen rider was unseated after clipping heels with the #8 Ethan Hunt. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the rider involved in the judgment of the Stewards this effected the outcome of the race and #8 Ethan Hunt is disqualified from third place and placed last. Decision is unanimous. New order of finish: 2, 1, 6, 5, 10, 7, 9, 3, 4, 8.

Equine Death Race 3- #1A Bonita Luna trained by Oscar Barrera III and ridden by Eric Cancel was pulled up and taken off on the horse ambulance and was later found to have a left front leg fracture and was humanely euthanized.

Stewards Inquiry Race 10- Inquiry into the stretch run, in the vicinity of the 1/16 pole #9 Maybry's Conquest (Luis Saez) ducks sharply into the inside rail then falls unseating her rider. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards #9 Maybry's Conquest caused her own problems and the race is official as is. Decision is unanimous.

Incident Race 10- #9 Maybry's Conquest trained by George Weaver and ridden by Luis Saez falls into the portable rail in the vicinity of the 1/16 pole unseating the rider. Both horse and rider were able to walk off the track under their own power.

Incident Race 10- #11 Mind That Diamond trained by Patrick Quick and ridden by Jacqueline Davis was pulled up in the stretch and taken off on the horse ambulance.

Stewards Inquiry Race 9- Inquiry into the stretch run, in the vicinity of the 1/16 pole #9 Alabama Bound (Luis Saez) shifts in and #7 Out of Nowhere (Kendrick Carmouche) while racing in tight quarters has to briefly steady. #9 Alabama Bound goes on to finish second and #7 Out of Nowhere finishes sixth. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident did not alter the finish of the race and the race is official as is. Decision is unanimous.

Incident Race 6- #5 Too Wild to Repent trained by Michael Miceli and ridden by Eric Cancel fell after crossing the finish line in first and unseated the rider. Horse was taken off on the horse ambulance.

Incident Race 6- #3 Big East trained by Bruce Levine and ridden by Manuel Franco unseated the rider after going over a horse that had fallen after the finish line.
