After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 7- Inquiry into the start, #9 Hidden Warrior (Taylor Rice) was fractious in the gate and turned his head just before the gate opens. The assistant starter straightened his head and released him immediately but he still broke slowly several lengths behind the field. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the rider involved in the judgment of the Stewards the start was not impeded and no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Equine Death Race 5- #5 Animal Kracker trained by Thomas Bush and ridden by Jose Ortiz was pulled up at the 1/8 pole and was taken off the track on the horse ambulance and it was later determined that he fractured both right front sesamoids and was humanely euthanized.

Stewards Inquiry Race 4- Inquiry into the start, #9 Sunrise Lover (Melvin Perez) rider and assistant starter came together at the break causing the rider to lose his balance and his irons. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the rider involved in the judgment of the Stewards the horses chances were compromised leaving the gate and #9 Sunrise Lover ran for purse money only and all bets are refunded. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 7- Jockey of the second place finisher #2 Sonora (Javier Castellano) claims foul against the first place finisher #8 Non Finisce Mai (Rajiv Maragh) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 3/16 pole #8 Non Finisce Mai drifts in making contact with #2 Sonora and both horses continue evenly while #8 Non Finisce Mai drifts out and draws in front to win in the final strides. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.
