Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 8- Jockey of the fifth place finisher #2 Regardez (Irad Ortiz, Jr.) claims foul against the first place finisher #5 Evidently (Joel Rosario) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/16 pole #5 Evidently shifts in and makes contact with #2 Regardez who steadies. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #5 Evidently is disqualified from first and placed fifth. New order of finish is 7, 1, 6, 2, 5, 4. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 3- #6 Slam Chowder trained by Eddie Kenneally and ridden by Javier Castellano was eased to the wire and walked off the track under her own power.

Stewards Inquiry Race 1- Inquiry in the vicinity of the ½ mile pole, #3 Sandy Strikes (Paco Lopez) takes a bad step and loses his action for several strides. He recovers to gallop the rest of the race far behind the field. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the rider involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 8- Jockey of the seventh place finisher #1 Morandi (Irad Ortiz, Jr.) claims foul against the second place finisher #5 Can'thelpbelieving (Javier Castellano) for alleged interference in the vicinity of the 3/8 pole. #5 Can'thelpbelieving makes contact with #1 Morandi, inside on the rail, causing him to take up sharply and lose all momentum. #1 Morandi recovers to gallop slowly to the wire. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #5 Can'thelpbelieving is disqualified from second and placed seventh. New order of finish is 7, 2, 4, 3, 6, 1, 5. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #7 Most Happy Fella (Charlie Amaro) claims foul against the third place finisher #4 Flash Paws (Eric Cancel) for alleged interference in the vicinity of the 1/8 pole. #4 Flash Paws drifts out forcing #7 Most Happy Fella to alter course and go around #6 Moneyinyour Pocket (Cornelio Velazquez). After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #4 Flash Paws is disqualified from third and placed fourth. New order of finish is 3, 6, 7, 4, 2, 5, 1. Decision was unanimous.
