Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 6- Jockey of the fifth place finisher #6 Not Today (Angel Castillo) claims foul against the first place finisher #7 Mills (Junior Alvarado) for alleged interference after the start. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 5- #1 Baby B trained by Richard Schosberg and ridden by Jose Ortiz was eased to the wire and walked off the track under his own power.

Marshall; Race 6- #7 Mills Claimed by Trainer David Jacobson for David Jacobson; Race 9- #4 Quibbler Claimed by Trainer Bruce Levine for Repole Stable

Ruling- John Velazquez- Jockey- You are hereby fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for misuse of the crop during the running of the 9th race at Belmont Park on July 4, 2015. Having appealed, a stay of the license suspension or revocation is hereby granted; however, Commission counsel may make a motion for the stay to be terminated in the event that the appeal hearing is not completed within 90 days of this ruling. If the stay is terminated because of an unreasonable delay in the completion of the hearing, then the license suspension or revocation would begin and run until the appeal hearing is completed. The licensee is also hereby granted a separate stay that will begin only after the appeal hearing is completed. This second stay will terminate when the Commission issues its final agency action (e.g., finding and order).

Stewards Inquiry Race 5- Inquiry into the start and in the vicinity of the 1/2 mile pole. At the start, #11 Winter Wish (Luis Saez) stumbles badly but recovers to finish third and no other horses were involved. In the vicinity of the 1/2 mile pole #7 Yourcreditsgood (Rajiv Maragh) clips heels with #5 Mini Muffin (Rubin Silvera) and falls and unseats her rider. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders of #5 Mini Muffin and #10 Meet in Khartoum (Angel Cruz) in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #5 Mini Muffin is disqualified from fifth and unplaced in the order of finish. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 9- Inquiry into the start as the gates open there was contact between #5 Super Psyche (Junior Alvarado), #6 Uncle Chester (Irada Ortiz, Jr.) and #7 Mohican Chief (Javier Castellano). Irada Ortiz, Jr. was unseated due to the contact at the start. After reviewing the race video and speaking with the riders of #5 Super Psyche and #6 Uncle Chester in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 5- #7 Yourcreditsgood trained by Joseph Orseno and ridden by Rajiv Maragh clipped heels with #5 Mini Muffin at the half mile pole causing #7 Yourcreditsgood to go down unseating his rider. Rajiv Maragh was taken to the hospital and horse was able to walk off the track under his own power.

Incident Race 7- #1 Identity Crisis trained by Carlos Martin and ridden by Manuel Franco was taken off on the horse ambulance after the finish of the race.

Incident Race 9- #6 Uncle Chester trained by Leah Gyarmati and ridden by Irada Ortiz, Jr. unseated his rider at the start.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 1- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #5 D'funnything (Manuel Franco) claims foul against the third place finisher #8 The Undersheriff (Luis Saez) for alleged interference in the stretch. In the vicinity of the 1/8 pole #8 The Undersheriff drifts out under a left handed crop and #5 D'funnything has to steady thereby stopping his momentum. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards the incident altered the finish of the race and #8 The Undersheriff is disqualified from third and placed fourth. New order of finish is 1, 6, 5, 8, 4, 9, 2, 7, 3. Decision was unanimous.

Equine Death Race 3- #3 Lord Cashel trained by Joe Sharp and ridden by Manuel Franco sustained a right front leg fracture in the race and was humanely euthanized on July 15, 2015.

Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 7- Jockey of the second place finisher #9 Barrel of Dreams (Kendrick Carmouche) claims foul against the first place finisher #6 My Kinda Gal (Eric Cancel) for alleged interference in the stretch. #9 Barrel of Dreams and #6 My Kinda Gal race close together after the 1/16 pole with the #9 Barrel of Dreams on the outside. There is incidental contact by these horses just before the wire. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Stewards Inquiry Race 8- Inquiry into the start, #10 H Man (Kendrick Carmouche) throws his head at the start of the race and no other horses were involved. After reviewing the race video in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.

Incident Race 7- #10 Downtown Alley trained by Leah Gyarmati and ridden by Taylor Rice was taken off the horse ambulance after the finish of the race.
