Stewards Inquiry and Jockey Objection Race 8- Jockey of the fourth place finisher #8 Saratoga Dreamer (Irado Ortiz, Jr.) claims foul against second place finisher #10 Sandy's Slew (Junior Alvarado) for alleged interference in the stretch. In deep stretch, #10 Sandy's Slew does drift out under a left handed crop crossing in front of #8 Saratoga Dreamer, though he was clear at the time. #8 Saratoga Dreamer checks reacting to #10 Sandy's Slew coming out and bumps #2 Summer Breezing (Jose Lezcano) as a result. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.
