In the vicinity of the 1/4 pole #7 Grandpa's Princess steadies in traffic with #8 Rachel's Temper passing outside. #2 Familyofroses steadies between horses in deep stretch with #1 Awesome Quick (Eric Cancel) on the rail and drifting out and #8 Rachel's Temper passing outside. After reviewing the race video and speaking with all riders involved in the judgment of the Stewards no action was warranted. Decision was unanimous.
