




The New York State Gaming Commission's Lottery and Video Lottery Gaming Divisions made history in fiscal year 2018-19; becoming the first Lottery operations in North America to break \$10 Billion in combined sales and net win. The achievement - fueled by an industry best \$8.208 Billion in Lottery sales coupled with a remarkable \$2.08 Billion in Video Lottery Gaming net machine income – produced \$3.47 Billion in profit to support New York's schools.

The Gaming Commission itself earned the global gaming industry's highest level of achievement – Level 4 Certification - from the World Lottery Association for incorporating responsible gaming principles into its everyday business practices. The honor also recognizes the Commission's commitment to continuous improvement.




Traditional Lottery (FY 2018-2019) \$8.208 Billion in Sales

The above amounts are based on the New York State Education Department's Division of Aid to Localities for Education from the State Lottery Fund as required by law. For a complete listing visit nylottery.ny.gov.

Lottery revenue is distributed to local school districts by the same statutory formula used to distribute other state aid to education. It takes into account both a school district's size and its income level; larger, lower-income school districts receive proportionately larger shares of Lottery school funding.
