- Free Play Allowance:** The amount of promotional free play included in Credits Played that is subsidized by the State through a reduction to Net Win.
- Credits Won:** The amount of onscreen credits won on a VGM (prize payout). Also includes any progressive jackpot liability due to players.
- Net Win:** The net revenues remaining after payout of prizes to players. (Credits Played less Credits Won) Net win is commonly referred to as "Hold" or "Net Machine Income".

### Aid to Municipalities with Video Lottery Gaming Facilities Program

Beginning in FY 07/08, in accordance with Section 54-L of the State Finance Law, cities, counties, towns, or villages that host a video lottery gaming facility will receive annual aid payments from the Office of the State Comptroller. State aid payments made to an eligible municipality are used to defray local costs associated with a video lottery gaming facility, to reduce real property taxes, or to increase support for public schools.
